The entry fee for all Saturday and Sunday NYR&CBA Shows is \$3.25 per animal per show. Fur entries are \$1.50 per animal per show. Phone entries from Canadian exhibitors will be accepted on Wednesday – September 21, 2011 from 6-9PM!

E-mail CHANGES ONLY will be allowed through September 25th – PLEASE DO NOT ask for exceptions. If you do not show after emailing your entry you will still be responsible for your entry fees.

Changes on the day of show in the same breed, sex and class will be charged \$2.00 per change. Day of show entries will be charged \$6.00 per animal per show entered. Remark cards will not be prepared in advance for Open, Youth or Specialty Shows. If you would like remark cards you may get them from the Show Secretary so you can fill them out and give them to the writer at the time of judging.

NYR&CBA SHOW RULES

1. This is an **official ARBA Show** and will be governed by the latest rules of such.
2. All Open & Youth rabbits for all shows will be judged by **private ear number**.
3. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed in the **left ear**.
4. All carrying cages must have **leak proof bottoms**.
5. Exhibitors will be responsible for **carrying their own rabbits to and from judging tables**. To avoid delays the “2 call” rule will apply at the discretion of the judge.
6. NYR&CBA reserves the **right to substitute judges**.
7. **Sick animals will be removed** from the showroom and entries will be forfeited.
8. **Anyone causing a disturbance** or trying to intimidate a judge **will be asked to leave** and their entry fee will be forfeited.
9. All **returned checks** will be charged a **\$20.00 fee** the first and second time they are deposited.
10. All **children must be supervised** at all times.
11. **No alcoholic beverages** are allowed in the showroom.
12. **Vendors** are welcome, but must **contact Debbie Vecchio in advance** of the show.
13. **Ribbons will be given through 3rd Place**. All trophies, paybacks, etc. must be picked up at the Secretary’s table. **None will be mailed**.
14. **NO DOGS, CATS, etc.** will be allowed in the showroom.
15. We will have **separate areas for Cavies, blowers for Angoras**. Youth rabbits will be cooped in same area as Open rabbits.
16. There must be **10 or more** shown in a sanctioned breed before a **trophy or payback** will be given and for a breed to be sanctioned at the 2012 show.
17. **Remark cards WILL NOT be prepared** in advance for Open, Youth or Specialty Shows. Remark cards will be available at the Show Secretary’s Table. **You must fill out your own** remark card and present it to the writer at the time of judging. It is the writer’s responsibility to complete your card if requested.
18. **Youth must carry their own rabbits** to and from judging tables.

COOPING INSTUCTIONS & RULES

The NYR&CBA *will not reserve coops* and coops will not be allowed roped off or otherwise reserved for later use. *All cooping is on a first come, first serve basis.* If you plan to coop, you may want to arrive on Friday afternoon. You must supply your own shavings, food and water dishes for cooped animals. We do not supply shavings!

YOU MUST ALSO SUPPLY YOUR OWN RISERS FOR ANGORAS – WE DO NOT SUPPLY RISERS.

Once again several youth contests will take place during the Grand Finals show. Please pay special attention to the contest rules and times, so that you are not disappointed.

****Youth wishing to compete in the BREED ID CONTEST, SHOWMANSHIP, JUDGING and/or ROYALTY CONTEST must pre-register by September 23, 2011. Registrations must be sent to Paula Schutz either by mail or email, and must include youth name, age, and which contests you are entering.**

The **ROYALTY CONTEST** is judged in 4 age categories: under 9 years old, 9-11 years old, 12-14 years old and 15-18 years old. To compete in royalty, all youth must complete all 3 contests which include breed ID, a written test, showmanship for those 11 and under, and judging for those 12 and over.

~The **BREED ID CONTEST** will be held at 6-8PM Friday night in the showroom. There will be no time on Saturday to participate in this contest.

~The **WRITTEN TEST** will be given at 8AM on Saturday morning. This will be the only time this test will be given. The written test should take about 15 minutes to complete.

~The **JUDGING CONTEST** will be held at 6-8PM Friday night in the showroom, and is open to those ages 12 and up. Participants will need to bring a Standards of Perfection. There will be no time on Saturday to participate in this contest.

~**SHOWMANSHIP** will be held on Friday evening and on Saturday morning, and is open to all ages, but it is required for those 11 and under who are competing in the royalty contest.

EDUCATIONAL CONTESTS will be available, and youth may bring 1 item in each of the following areas: art, wood, posters, educational displays, sewing, crafts, and photography. Projects must be rabbit/cavy themed! These items do not have to be pre-entered. Bring them to the youth area upon entering the showroom.

~Winners of the youth contests will be announced during the banquet on Saturday night. Special recognition will be given to the winners at this time.

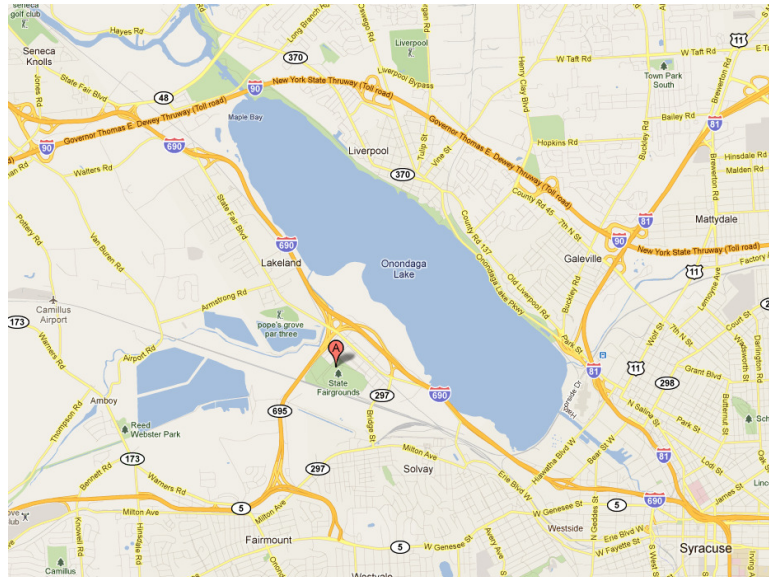
